Historic Harlem Townhouse Lists for \$4.6M



An <u>historic Harlem home</u> hit the market and we're obsessed. Located at 13 West 121st Street in the Mount Morris Historic District, the charming NYC brownstone features spacious amenities with five bedrooms, 4.5 bathrooms, and 4,500 square feet of space as well as its own private garden and outdoor area.

Built in 1887, the four-floor, 11-room home also features lovely details at every turn, such as ornate wood cornices, stunning banisters and stairs with original wainscoting and paneling, and decorative fireplaces with original mantels; new hardwood floors styled to be consistent with the traditional feel of the home, and a garden with its own entrance.

Additional details include bookcases with a library ladder, a fully equipped kitchen with stainless steel appliances and a soundproofed master bedroom with two closets and large windows overlooking the garden, to name a few features.
