AROUND TOWN: EAST END AVENUE An Urban Oasis And So Much More



East End Avenue is the kind of street most New Yorkers might miss as they go to a favorite restaurant, shop, or club. You have to be looking for it. The neighborhood that it anchors, hugging the edge of the Upper East Side, traverses only 13 blocks or so with streets often ending in culde-sacs, giving the area an almost gated feel.

Adding to the appeal of this little pocket of Manhattan are the streets leading to Carl Schurz Park plus the front-seat view of the boat parade along the East River. 25 EAST END AVE. #7E

Calm and serene water views welcome you to this unique pre-war home on East End Avenue with over 27 feet of frontage on the river. A semi-private landing leads to the ample foyer of this spacious apartment. The living room takes full advantage of its picture windows, offering spectacular water views.

The oversized dining room also overlooks the river and opens through double pocket doors to the newly renovated windowed kitchen. The eat-in kitchen has top-of-the-line appliances, including a Viking stove, double ovens, a Miele dishwasher, and a Sub-Zero refrigerator. A home office/study/staff room with a fourth bath sits tucked away between the kitchen and the additional space offered by a butler's pantry. The three bedrooms are off a private hall, each with its ensuite bathroom, custom closets, and western views for enjoying the spectacular NYC sunsets. The primary bedroom has two walk-in closets, and the entire home has an abundance of closets and storage. Additional must-have conveniences include through the wall A/C and a Bosch washer/dryer. Design elements throughout include hardwood floors, crown molding, and 9' 2" ceilings.

25 East End Avenue is a full-service building built-in 1928. Each apartment has a storage unit. In addition, there is a fitness center, bike storage, and a live-in super. 

A private corridor leads to a wing of three large bedrooms, all with eastern exposures.

The primary bedroom features two separate marble bathrooms, a windowed sitting area, three substantial walk-in closets, and a built-in desk. Beautiful cabinetry gives extra depth and storage to the room in the most discrete way. Two additional spacious bedrooms share a marbled bath, and one of them has a murphy bed concealed behind sliding bookcases. The large fourth bedroom at the opposite side of the apartment has south-facing city views of iconic buildings.

It functions as a family room/den. It is a quiet place to relax with its decorative fireplace, wall of custom bookcases and cabinetry, en-suite bathroom, and two oversized walk-in closets. The laundry room, formerly a powder room, has a washer, dryer, and sink, completing the amenities of this dream home.

60 East End Avenue was built as a cooperative residence. It features three apartments per floor, a live-in resident manager, a full-time concierge and door attendant, dedicated staff, individual private storage, a fitness center, bike room, and a laundry room.
